

PLIB meeting minutes – 7/11/12

1. Meeting called to order at 7:00 – all present, minus Cathy.
2. Arden motioned to approve prior minutes, second by Elaine; motion carried.
3. Public Comment
 - a. Marilyn R. – update on Walleye stocked in the lake
 - b. Marilyn S. – update on PLA kayak event and information on the PLA sponsored boating safety class.
 - c. Question from resident – Can the PLA stop any herbicide treatments to the lake? Answer (Arden) – the DEQ will have the final say on any permit application in this regard.
 - d. Mike I. – Comments regarding assessment to his property. Answer (Elaine) – You need to fill in a SAD change form and turn it in.
 - e. Rosemary C – update on the FoPL's annual chicken fry.
 - f. Bob S. – If the FoPL's permit is approved for herbicide treatment, how will this affect our project? Answer (Jennifer Jones) – It will have an adverse effect on our project and any data collected.
 - g. Arden has contacted a photographer to come to the lake and take photos.
 - h. Dick Moster commented his groups plans for herbicide treatment.
 - i. Paul talked about compressor noise at the Pachy Rd. site. Noise reduction options were discussed.
4. Appearances

 - b. Jennifer – gave a brief update on the base line survey done in the lake which included core samples. There was significant weevil damage in the west bay and more damage on the north end than the south end. If we stock more, we should put them in the east end of the lake. Jennifer will make further more detailed recommendations at the next meeting. After all data from the survey has been compiled, Jennifer will be looking into possible funding/grant opportunities for our project.
 - i. Question from audience – Will the bacteria treatment effect the weevils? Answer (Jennifer) – No.
