

PLIB minutes for Public Hearing on 9/21/12

The Board met this evening to approve a budget for the new fiscal year.

1. Question: Jim – How much will we have in the “kitty” at the end of this fiscal year. Answer: Cathy – We’ll have around 30,000.00 left
2. Cathy – We will be receiving a large chunk of money from the SAD next week and we’ll need to start paying back the township
3. Question: Elaine – If we end up with a large positive balance next year, will we then be able to bring down the tax amount that each individual pays? Answer: Cathy – Yes, we can then lower it but everything will depend on the feasibility study.

The Board now adjourned and opened a regular meeting

1. The Board voted to accept the 2013 budget. All except Paul (who was not in attendance) unanimously passed the motion.
2. Elaine stated that the Board could have the McCollough shore tested at a discount by taking advantage of the fact that LSSU is already performing a survey in the area on behalf of the PLA. The Board agreed to take advantage of the savings.
