

PLIB Meeting Minutes – 8-9-17

1. Meeting called to order, all present.
2. Arden moved to approve the minutes from the April 1st meeting, Bob seconded. Motion carried.
3. Treasurer's Report – Bob presented an accounting of all transactions from 10/1/16 through 8/9/17. The Board agreed that all looked good.
4. Appearances
 - a. Mike Soloman announced that the survey crew has been scheduled for August 22. They will be conducting a plant survey and doing water quality tests.
 - b. Paul Moore and his team of undergrad researchers from the U of M Biological Station gave a presentation highlighting the types of tests they performed for the study. Results coming soon.
5. Old Business
 - a. Blake's Beach is showing improvement. There was minimal accumulation of plant material in comparison to the last couple of years. Some residents along this area commented that they are seeing more intact weeds on their shores, however, and a discussion on what to do with them ensued. It was suggested that they might be used for fertilizer. Another idea was having them picked up.
 - b. The DEQ permit to continue with the project was granted for one year. Once the Biological Station has completed their study, the results will be forwarded to the "powers that be" in the interest of extending the permit to five years.
 - c. The permit request for the North Shore air pump is on hold for now.
6. New Business
 - a. The Schedule for the September 13th Public Hearing will be as follows: 7:00 the Public Hearing meeting will come to order then, after a brief adjournment, the regular meeting will be called to order.
 - b. A discussion was held in order to decide where to store old PLIB documents. It was suggested that they be held in Bill's old office.
 - c. Four SAD Roll changes were made. Arden moved to approve the changes, Elaine seconded. Motion carried.
7. Presentation of the bills. Arden motioned that we bring them current, Elaine seconded. Motion carried.
8. Public Comment – Donna Spotts on the use of chemicals on Mitchell Lake. A public conversation followed.
