### **Paradise Lake Improvement Board Minutes – August 10, 2022 Regular Meeting**

The meeting began at 7:14 P.M.

Present were: Paul Teike, Arden Bawkey, John Siegel, Toni Drier, Ash Alt

**Secretary:** Bawkey moved, Alt seconded a motion to approve the minutes from July 13. Motion passed.

Correspondence was an email from Pickerel Lake which had been forwarded to RLS.

**Treasurer:** Alt presented the 2021-2022 Budget Report. Report accepted. Bawkey moved, Alt seconded a motion to close the electric accounts for former laminar flo operations. Motion Passed.

**RLS Presentation:** Mike Solomon reported that 20.5A were treated with herbicide on July 19. Cost was \$119992.50. 2.1 A by Stoney Point will be treated tomorrow at a cost of \$1755. Four properties in Hebron Township had the waterfront treated. The half-life of the herbicides used is 1-6 days.

**New Business:** Alt summarized the Budget Resolution for 2022-2023. Moved by Bawkey, seconded by Siegel to approve the Resolution. Roll call vote: all aye. Resolution passes.

Teike suggested that the pump houses be removed and offered initially to the Paradise Lake Association (PLA) as it built them originally. Moved by Drier, seconded by Bawkey to remove the pump houses and electric poles and offer the houses to the PLA. Motion passed. Teike will find someone to take the poles as they should be good to use at construction sites for temporary electric wires.
